### **GIBRALTAR SPRING FESTIVAL 2015 SPRING VISUAL ARTS COMPETITION**

Gibraltar Cultural Services on behalf of the Ministry of Culture, will be holding a Spring Visual Arts Competition in June 2015 as part of the Gibraltar Spring Festival.

The competition will see changes to previous editions with innovations in the accepted art forms. The new categories added include digital art, video, photography and installations. This is in line with Government's policy of promoting contemporary arts in Gibraltar and abroad.

The visual arts competition is open to Gibraltarians and residents of Gibraltar aged 16 and over as at 16<sup>th</sup> June 2015. A maximum of two entries may be submitted by each artist. Works must be original and not previously entered competitively, except for entries submitted in the Ministry's art competition for Young Artists.

Entries will be exhibited at the John Mackintosh Hall from the 17<sup>th</sup> to the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2015.
